Scholarship Information, Procedure, and Application  
Member at Large Scholarship

The members of the Mother Lode Gun Club, through an appointed committee, will award one (1) \$500 scholarship to a **club member, child, grandchild, or great-grandchild of a member who is a high school** senior or older who seriously intends to enroll in post high school education, or currently attends one of the following: junior college, state college or university, trade school, POST academy.

The criteria for awarding the scholarship will be based on the successful completion of an essay, approximately 500 to 1,000 words, on the following:

1. Why was the Second Amendment originally included in the U.S. Constitution?
2. Why do you feel the Second Amendment is still important today?
3. If the Second Amendment had never been included in the U.S. Constitution, what do you think the country would be like today?

The essay should be typed, double-spaced, with grammar/spelling correct, and sources cited. Plagiarism will result in the disqualification of the essay.

Application Procedure

Applicants will complete the attached MLGC Scholarship Application and submit it directly to the following address no later than April 3, 2009:

Page 1 will be the MLGC application; the next pages will be your essay and work cited; the last page (attached) print your information. It is important that no name appear anywhere on the application or essay, except on the last page that is included in your application package. Also, please leave any name off of the return label and show only an address. This is to keep the committee's selection non-biased. Staple it all together, fold if you wish, and mail to the above address.

Requirements for Scholarship Recipients

The winner will be required to provide proof of registration and fulltime status in their post high school training. Proof of registration should be sent to the above address no later than October 15, 2009. The Committee will then authorize the release of scholarship funds. The winner will be requested to attend a MLGC meeting for recognition of their accomplishment if at all possible.
